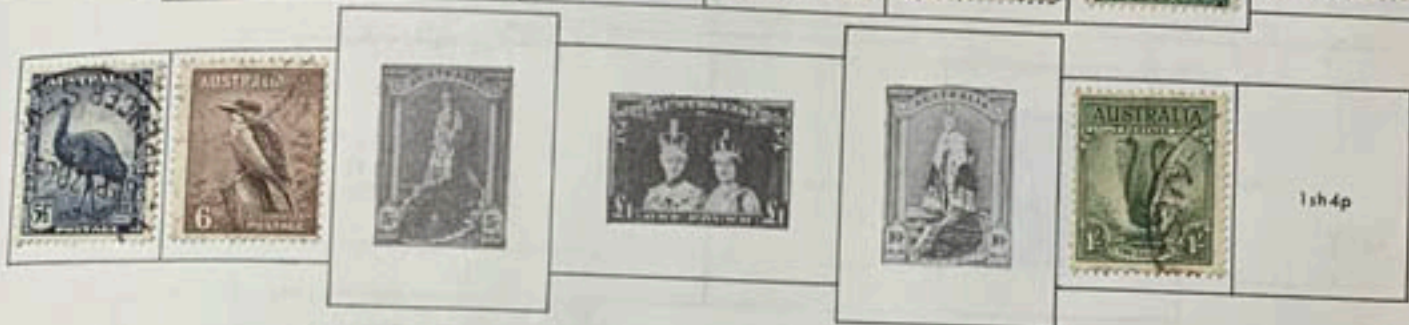

AUSTRIA - ÖSTERREICH









After the First World War, in 1918, the various nationalities of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy established their own states. The remaining German-speaking parts formed the Austrian republic. The republic is situated in Central Europe and has an area of 32,388 sq. mi. Population: 7,057,140 (1948 est.). Language: German. Capital: Vienna (1,730,000). Part of Germany from 1938 to 1945. 100 Heller = 1 Krone. Since 1925: 100 Groschen = 1 Schilling.

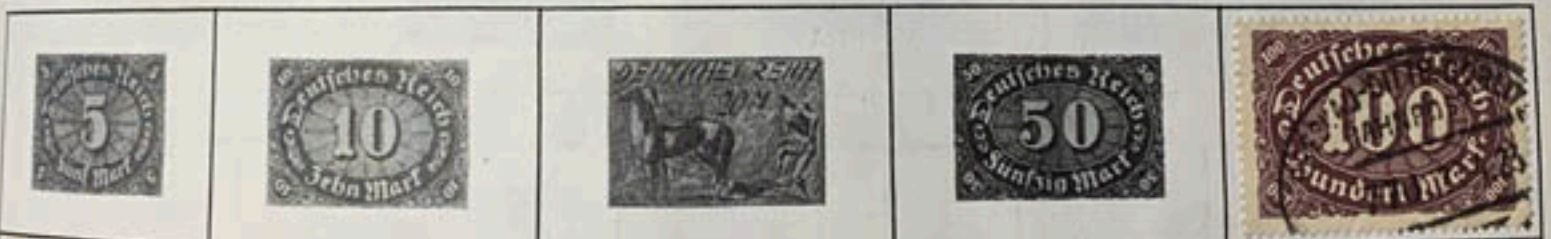
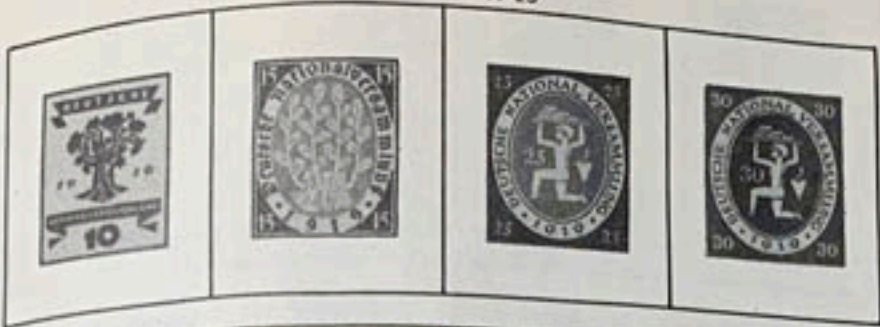

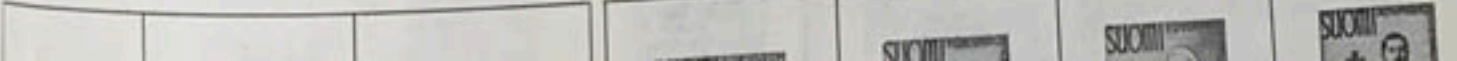

CZECHOSLOVAKIA – ČESKOSLOVENSKO

A republic in Central Europe. Area: 49,353 sq. mi.; pop.: 12,340,000 (est. 1948); cap.: Prague (925,000). Languages: Czech and Slovak. Major exports: glass, machinery, metal, textile, coal, wood, paper. The republic was established after the collapse of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy in 1918. From 1939 to 1945, its western parts were the German protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia. Slovakia was independent, and Subcarpathian Ruthenia, in the east of the republic, was occupied by Hungary. Czechoslovakia was re-established in 1945 without S. Ruthenia which was granted to the Soviet Union. 100 Haleru = 1 Koruna.

RUSSIA

An Empire until 1917. The Union of Soviet Socialist Republics is a federation of 16 republics with a total area of 8,436,121 sq. mi.; pop.: approx. 210,000,000; cap.: Moscow (4,200,000). Nationalities: Russians (about 58%), Ukrainians (about 17%), Byelorussians (about 3.1%), Uzbeks (2.9%), Tatars (2.5%), Kazakhs (1.8%), Jews (1.8%), and about 90 other nationalities speaking different languages. Major exports: grains, lumber, furs, petroleum, cotton goods, fertilizers, sugar, iron, steel and iron products, coal. 100 Kopecks = 1 Ruble.
