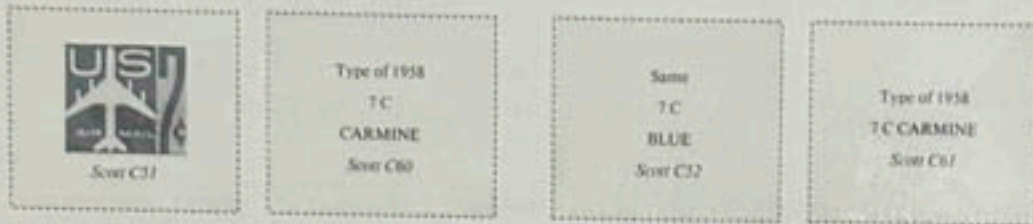

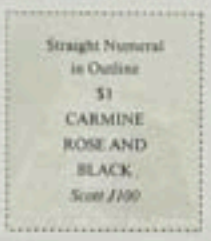

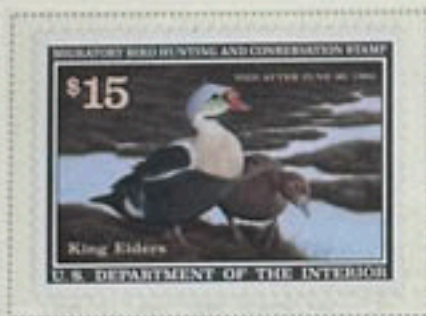

# UNITED STATES COMMEMORATIVES

## DANIEL BOONE

1968



*Tools of Boone's Trade*

Daniel Boone, the Pennsylvania-born Quaker, migrated to North Carolina in 1750, settling on the Yadkin River. He wandered, hunted, trapped and dodged Indians. In 1769, he led a party of settlers, including his wife and daughter, into Kentucky and founded Boonesborough. Boone took part in what was regarded as the last battle of the Revolutionary War.

## WALT DISNEY

*Walt Disney*

Walt Disney, who created Mickey Mouse and a succession of cartoon characters, was beloved by children of all ages throughout the world. His film career began in a garage-studio in the 1920's and he built his tiny venture into a giant entertainment enterprise. Disney passed away on December 15, 1966 at age 65.

Leif Erikson, the 11th Century Norse explorer, is honored by this issue. His bold voyage brought him to the New World some 500 years before Columbus. It was placed on sale in Seattle, Washington on Leif Erikson Day where an Erikson statue stands in the waterfront district.
