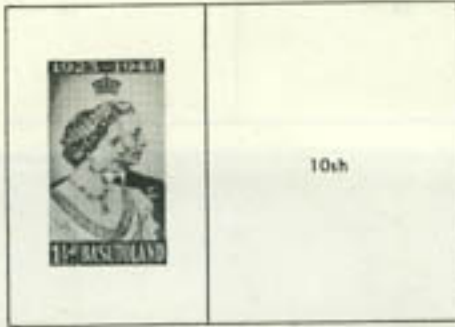

# BULGARIA



A republic in the eastern part of the Balkan peninsula bordering on the Black Sea. Area: 42,796 sq. mi.; pop.: 7,048,000 (est. 1947); cap.: Sofia (435,000). Languages: Bulgarian (88%), Turkish (10%). Chief exports: tobacco, fruit, eggs, wheat, corn. Stock raising. From 1878 to 1908 a principality under the sovereignty of Turkey. An independent kingdom from 1908 to 1946. 100 Stotinki = 1 Leva.

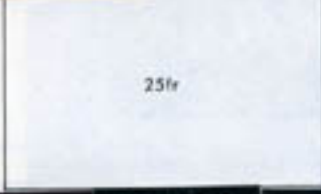

# ETHIOPIA - ABYSSINIA

An empire in northeast Africa. Area: about 350,000 sq. mi.; pop.: 8,000,000 (est. Dec. 1948); cap.: Addis Ababa (250,000). Official language: Amharic. Chief exports: coffee and hides. The rulers of Abyssinia claim to be direct descendants of Menelek I, the son of Solomon and the Queen of Sheba. This tradition is reflected in the designs of Abyssinian postage stamps. Since 1936: 100 Centimes = 1 Thaler.

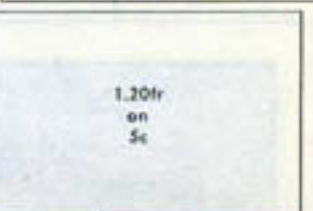
