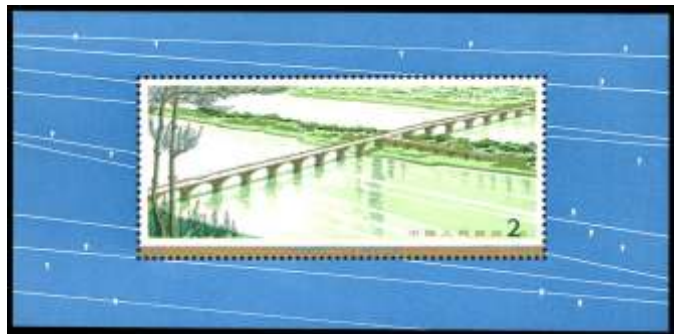

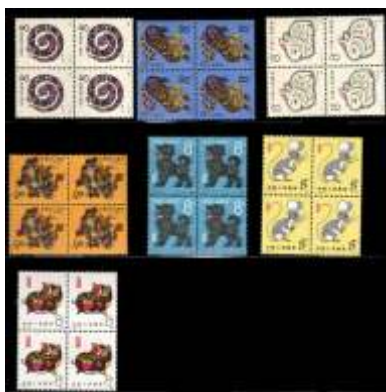

53 **Baker, Conrad, Harriman, Walter and Humphreys, Benjamin G.** Trio of signed calling cards embossed with the state seal from 1867 by the Governors of the States of Indiana, New Hampshire and Mississippi;

Conrad Baker (February 12, 1817 - April 28, 1885) was an American attorney, military officer, and politician who served as state representative, 15th lieutenant governor, and the 15th governor of the U.S. state of Indiana from 1867 to 1873. Baker had served in the Union Army during the American Civil War, rising to the rank of colonel, but resigned following his election as lieutenant governor, during which time he played an important role in overseeing the formation and training of states levies. He served as acting-governor for five months during the illness of Governor Oliver Morton, and was elevated to Governor following Morton's resignation from office. During Baker's full term as governor, he focused primitively on the creation and improvement of institutions to help veterans and their families that had been disaffected by the war. He also championed the post-war federal constitutional amendments, and was able to successfully advocate their acceptance. This card signed while he was Lt. Governor 1867.

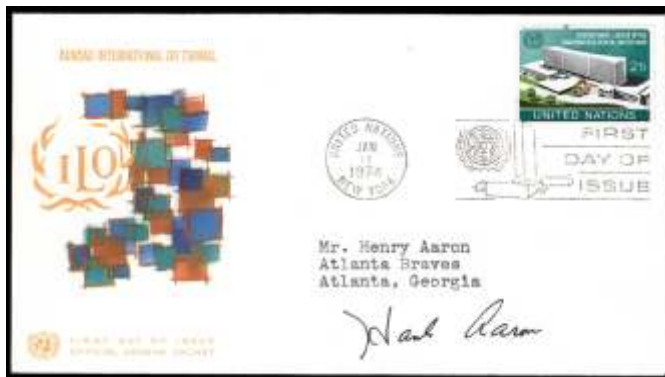
Walter Harriman (April 8, 1817 - July 25, 1884) was an American minister, merchant, soldier, and politician who served as the 31st governor of New Hampshire. He was a colonel in the Union Army during the American Civil War. On July 23, 1866, the United States Senate confirmed President Andrew Johnson's May 31, 1866 nomination of Harriman for appointment to the grade of brevet brigadier general of volunteers to rank from March 13, 1865.

Benjamin Grubs Humphreys (August 26, 1808 - December 20, 1882) was an American politician from Mississippi. He was a general in the Confederate States Army during the American Civil War and served as Governor of Mississippi from 1865 to 1868, during Reconstruction.

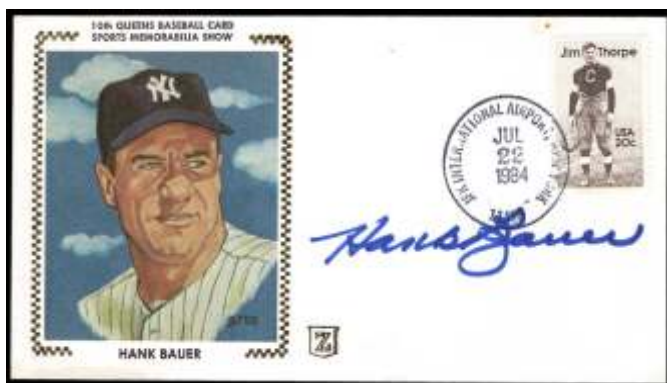

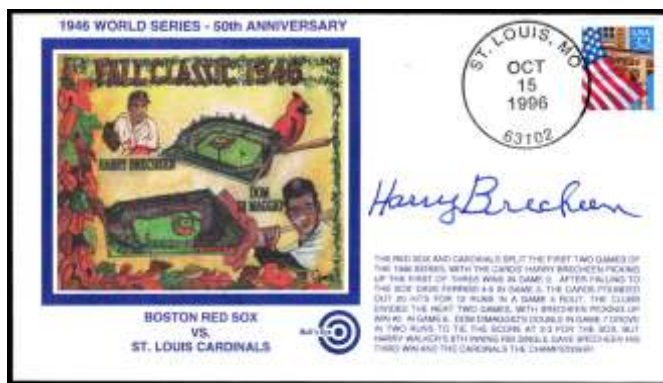

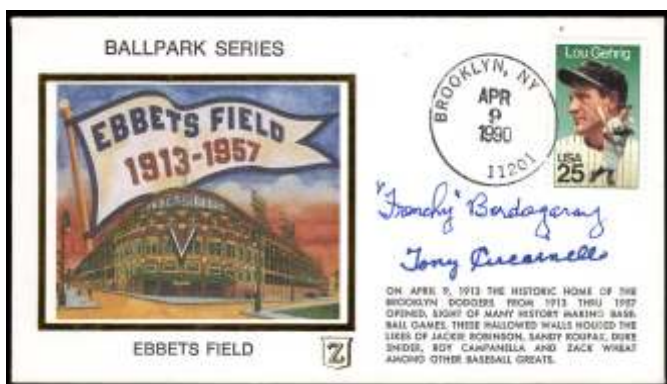

His signature on a FDC postmarked from the U.N in New York 1/11/74 and addressed to him in care of the Atlanta Braves in Atlanta, GA. Estimate \$75 - 100



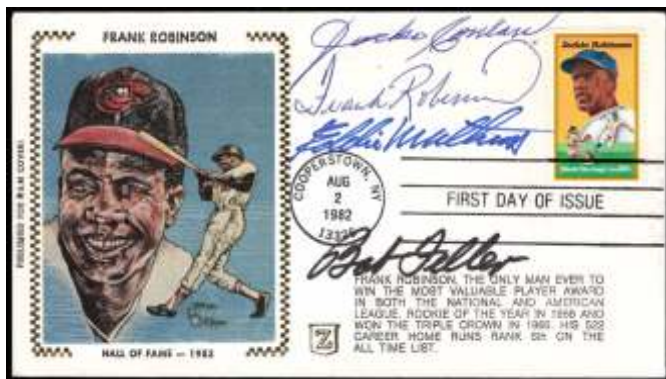
54 **Bauer, Hank**, 1922-2007, Henry Albert Bauer was an American right fielder and manager in Major League Baseball. He played with the New York Yankees and Kansas City Athletics; he batted and threw right-handed. His signature on a colorful cacheted cover of him postmarked from JFK International Airport on 7/22/1984, Very Fine. Estimate \$40 - 60



56 **Brecheen, Harry**, 1914-2004, Harry David Brecheen, nicknamed "the Cat", was an American left-handed pitcher in Major League Baseball who played most of his career for the St. Louis Cardinals. His signature on a colorful cacheted envelope commemorating the 50th anniversary of the 1946 World Series where Brecheen earned his third win and the championship. Postmarked St. Louis, MO 10/15/1996 comes with a COA and is numbered 235/450 on reverse. Estimate \$50 - 75



55 **Bordagaray, "Frenchy" and Cuccinello, Tony**, 1910-2000, born Stanley George "Frenchy" Bordagaray was an American professional baseball player. He played in Major League Baseball as an outfielder and third baseman for the Chicago White Sox, Brooklyn Dodgers, St. Louis Cardinals, Cincinnati Reds, and New York Yankees between 1934 and 1945. His signature along with Tony Cuccinello 1907-1995, born Anthony Francis Cuccinello was an American professional baseball second baseman and third baseman, then a longtime coach. He played in Major League Baseball for the Cincinnati Reds, Brooklyn Dodgers, Boston Bees / Braves, New York Giants and Chicago White Sox between 1930 and 1945. Two legendary ball players from the 1930's-40's on colorful cacheted cover featuring Ebbets Field, postmarked Brooklyn, NY 4/9/1990 and features a Lou Gehrig postage stamp. Includes a COA that states that less than 200 of these were personally signed by the duo. Estimate \$50 - 75



57 **Conlan, Jocko; Robinson, Frank; Matthews, Eddie; Feller, Bob**, 1935-2019, Frank Robinson, nicknamed “the Judge”, was an American professional baseball outfielder and manager in Major League Baseball who played for five teams over 21 seasons: the Cincinnati Reds, Baltimore Orioles, Los Angeles Dodgers, California Angels, and Cleveland Indians.

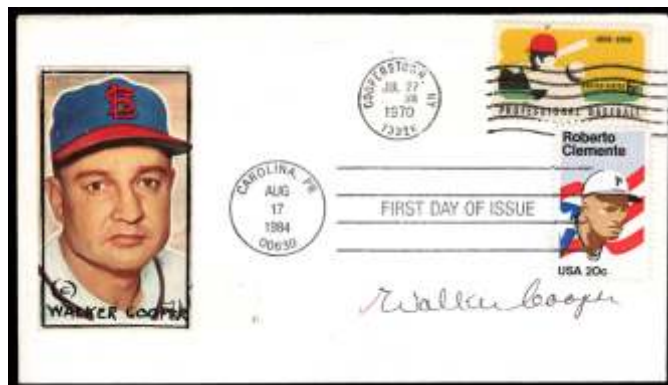
1899-1989, John Bertrand “Jocko” Conlan was an American baseball umpire who worked in the National League from 1941 to 1965. He had a brief career as an outfielder with the Chicago White Sox before entering umpiring. He umpired in five World Series and six All-Star Games.

1931-2001, Edwin Lee Mathews was an American professional baseball third baseman. He played in Major League Baseball for 17 seasons for the Boston / Milwaukee / Atlanta Braves; Houston Astros and Detroit Tigers.

Calbraith Perry Rodgers was the first man to fly across the United States. He undertook this flight in 1911 to win the \$50,000 prize offered by William Randolph Hearst. Rodgers' effort was supported by the Armour Company and Rodgers named his plane after their new grape soda, Vin Fiz. Armour's support allowed for construction of a special Wright plane, mechanics, and spare parts transported on a special train that followed below the airplane. The spare parts were essential because Rodgers crashed repeatedly. He did complete the transcontinental flight on December 10, 1911, but not within the time limit set for the Hearst prize. Sadly, Rodgers' met his demise in a fatal crash in his backup plane in Long Beach Harbor on April 3, 1912.
